LUNCH MEETING, SUNDAY 22 APRIL 2001

The world inside atoms has long been full of mysteries and is only recently being unraveled. What kind of matter exists, and what about anti-matter? We are very pleased to have a foremost world expert explain some of these mysteries in plain English. Our guest speaker will be the Dutch 1999 *Nobel Prize* winner in Physics:

PROFESSOR MARTINUS J.G. VELTMAN

who will take us on a: "Journey into the Sub-Atomic World".

He will explain in very simple terms the world of sub-atomic particles and the forces that are the building blocks of everything that exists in the universe. A history is given of important findings and experiments and the talk will be illustrated with a video.

Born in Waalwijk, Martinus (also called Tini) Veltman completed a Ph.D. in theoretical physics in Utrecht in 1963. After working at CERN (the European Laboratory for Particle Physics in Geneva) from 1961-1966 he was professor of theoretical physics at the University of Utrecht from 1966-1981 and MacArthur professor of physics at the University of Michigan, USA, from 1981-1997. Jointly with Prof Gerardus 't Hooft he received the Nobel Prize for Physics in 1999. Prof. Veltman is in Australia to receive an Honorary Doctorate at LaTrobe University in Melbourne.
